Dr. Srinivas Sridhara Division of Cost and Quality Analysis Maryland Health Care Commission

Srinivas Sridhara, PhD MHS manages the Division of Cost and Quality Analysis at the Maryland Health Care Commission. This Division is responsible for managing the Maryland Medical Care Database, which is Maryland's All Payer Claims Database, and generating various reports based on this data. These reports range from expenditure and payment rate trends to cost projections and analyses of the insurance markets in Maryland. Additional data sources, such as the Current Population Survey and the Medical Expenditure Panel Survey are used to report on the Maryland insurance market and insurance coverage. Dr. Sridhara also leads the Maryland Health Workforce Study, which will assess the quality and utility of the current data systems in Maryland and produce reports on the distribution of the existing supply of health care providers and demand for their services in Maryland.

Previously, Dr. Sridhara worked as the Senior Methodologist at MHCC, where his work ranged from reporting on health disparities and long term care services to managing data collection from Maryland long term care facilities and developing methods for assessing adequacy and forecasting need for health services in Maryland. Prior to working at the Commission, Dr. Sridhara worked at Johns Hopkins University and Baltimore Mental Health Systems. Dr. Sridhara received his masters and doctoral degrees from the Johns Hopkins Bloomberg School of Public Health.
